There will be no Monthly Meeting in March, 2012


Normal monthly meetings will resume on April 17th, 2012

Art group leader, Lynda Valcourt gave a brief explanation of how this rather large painting came to be, and a short biography of painter Jackson Pollock and his painting techniques that inspired the piece. Since Pollock's "Number 5" was recently sold for a reported \$140 million dollars, Marv instructed bidders that all bids should be in minimum increments of \$1,000. After a flurry of aggressive (fun) bidding, Marv brought the gavel down and awarded the painting to Barrie Brown for a winning bid (donation to the Food Bank) of \$105,000 (\$105).
